RN – Substance Use Disorder/MAT Clinic – Rochester, NY

Huther Doyle, a Substance Use Disorder and Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Outpatient clinic in Rochester, NY is seeking a full-time Registered Nurse.

Current unrestricted license in New York as a RN is required. A minimum of two (2) years of experience as an RN with exposure to and experience with treatment of Substance Use Disorders and addiction or a strong willingness to learn and develop professional skills in this area. The successful candidate must demonstrate a willingness to work as part of a multi-cultural staff delivering culturally appropriate services to a widely diverse client population.

- Review medical history of any individual admitted to outpatient addiction treatment, screening for health issues that would require referral or monitoring.
- Be familiar with telehealth platforms and utilize approved telehealth platforms per agency and OASAS guidelines for certain patient encounters and follow all protocol and procedure for privacy related to telehealth encounters. Record patient vital signs: pulse, temperature, blood pressure, weight, height. Document all health information in the electronic medical record.
- Educate staff and patients on available Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) for Substance Use Disorders and other health related topics including opioid overdose prevention trainings.
- Triage phone calls from patients and communicate with medical providers as appropriate.
- Coordinate services with pharmacist and other medical providers involved in patient's care.
- Process, test specimens obtained from patients (oral swabs, urine samples) under the direction of medical provider, following appropriate procedures and documenting results.
- Assist medical providers in rooming scheduled patients, collecting medical information, obtaining toxicology samples, documenting prescription monitoring program information on the record and administering medications per orders.
- Administer medications as permitted by your license under the orders of license medical provider, e.g. XR naltrexone and SC buprenorphine (Sublocade).
- Complete observed medication visits and medication count visits with patient under direction of medical provider.
- Follow protocols and treatment plan as indicated by medical provider for initial and follow up ambulatory withdrawal management services.
- Keep medication inventory updated and follow all procedures for storage and disposal of medications.
- Keep inventory of all medical supplies and order supplies when low.
- Keep inventory of Narcan and submit order through NYS Opioid Overdose Prevention Program when low.
