



Registered Nurse (RN)

Outpatient Substance Use Disorder Clinic

- Review medical history of any individual admitted to outpatient addiction treatment, screening for health issues that would require referral or monitoring.
- Maintain familiarity with telehealth platforms and utilize them per agency and OASAS guidelines for certain client encounters; follow all protocols and procedures for privacy related to telehealth encounters.
- Record patient vital signs: pulse, temperature, blood pressure, weight, height. Document all health information in the electronic health record.
- Educate staff and clients regarding available Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) for substance use disorders and other health related topics including opioid overdose prevention trainings.
- Triage phone calls from clients and communicate with medical providers as appropriate.
- Coordinate services with pharmacist and other medical providers associated with each client's individual care.
- Assist in the pre-authorization process for clients' medications.
- Process, test specimens obtained from clients (oral swabs, urine samples) under the direction of medical provider, following appropriate procedures and documenting results.
- Administer medications as permitted by license held under the orders of licensed medical provider e.g., XR naltrexone and SC buprenorphine (Sublocade).

Monday – Friday daytime position.

Current unrestricted license in New York as an RN is required. A minimum of two (2) year experience as an RN with exposure to and experience with treatment of substance use disorders and addiction or a strong willingness to learn and develop professional skills in this area.
